



‘WOOLLY WREATH & GARLAND’: Wool and the Gang Crazy Sexy Wool Version Instructions for re-yarning your Churchmouse Classics

‘Woolly Wreath & Garland’ using a super bulky-weight yarn.

Our original wreath and garland were knitted in a bulky-weight yarn, held double for the wreath, single for the garland.

Here, we played with a super bulky-weight yarn held single for both. Since a single strand of this yarn is so plump, we opted to use a bigger needle for the garland. We think the grand scale is charming!

Finished Size:	Small wreath: Approx. 14"/36cm finished diameter on 12"/30cm wreath form. Large wreath: Approx. 20"/51cm finished diameter on 18"/46cm wreath form. <i>Directions for small wreath; large in parentheses ().</i> Garland: Approx. 3 yds/m of length per 87 yds/80m skein.
Yarn:	Wreaths: 2 skeins Wool and the Gang Crazy Sexy Wool (87 yds/80m each) <u>held single throughout</u> . <i>Note: 2 skeins is enough for one 12" wreath with some yarn leftover <u>or</u> one 18" wreath without leftover yarn. You should be able to get two 12" wreaths out of 3 skeins.</i> Garland: 1 skein Wool and the Gang Crazy Sexy Wool (87 yds/80m each) <u>held single throughout</u> yields approx. 3 yds/m length.
Needles & Notions:	Wreaths: Same as original pattern. Garland: US 15 (10mm) double-point needles (two only).

*Please refer to the original pattern for complete instructions.
Only changes are covered in this adaptation. Read original instructions thoroughly.*

WREATH:	<u>Holding yarn single throughout</u> , follow instructions as directed in original pattern, until piece is long enough to wrap around wreath form without much stretching (we worked to approx. 36"/91cm for our 12"/30cm form and 54"/137cm for our 18"/46cm form). Refer to original pattern for finishing instructions. <i>Note: For dark yarn, do not use muslin strips to cover form.</i>
GARLAND:	<u>Holding yarn single throughout</u> , follow instructions as directed in original pattern for desired length. <i>Note: 1 skein should yield approx. 3 yds/m of garland.</i>

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
