

BETTER-THAN-BASIC PULLOVER': Ribbed Crew-Neck Version in Rowan *Kid Classic* Instructions for adding a crew-neck length to your Churchmouse Classics 'Better-Than-Basic Pullover' in Rowan *Kid Classic*.

Yarn: 9 (10, 10, 11, 12) skeins Rowan *Kid Classic* (153 yds/140m each). Or 1300 (1400, 1500,

1650, 1750) yds/1190 (1280, 1370, 1510, 1600)m of an equivalent worsted-weight yarn.

Needles US 8 (5mm) 24"/60cm circular needle or size to obtain gauge.

& Notions: US 7 (4.5mm) 24"/60cm and 16"/40cm circular needle, or 1 US size/.5mm smaller than

gauge size.

Please refer to the original pattern for complete instructions.

Only changes are covered in this adaptation.

Work collar: Work as Tunic-length Version. Use instructions for the K3/P2 ribbed collar, but instead of

working to 5"/13cm as in pattern, only work to 4"/10cm. Bind off very loosely in pattern. (Before stitching collar down, try it on over your head to be certain that your bind-off is

loose enough).

Fold collar to

inside:

Fold collar to the inside and loosely whip-stitch bound-off edge to inside neck edge; be sure

to keep stitching loose enough to get on over your head.
