



‘BIAS ‘BEFORE AND AFTER’ SCARF’: Lang Jawoll Magic Degradé Superwash Version
Instructions for re-yarning your Churchmouse Classics
‘Bias ‘Before and After’ Scarf’ using Lang Jawoll Magic Degradé Superwash.

- Finished Size:** Approx. 8"/20.5cm wide x 95"/241cm long, after blocking. Bias width across stitches (in direction of needle) will measure approx. 13"/33cm.
- Yarn:** 2 skeins Lang Jawoll Magic Degradé Superwash (437 yds/400m each).
Or approx. 625 yds/572m of an equivalent fingering-weight yarn.
- Gauge:** Approx. 19–20 sts = 4"/10cm in bias stockinette stitch, after blocking.

Please refer to the original pattern for complete instructions.
Only changes are covered in this adaptation. Read original instructions thoroughly.

- Provisional cast-on:** Following instructions on original pattern, chain 80 sts with waste yarn and crochet hook. Continue as directed in original pattern and knit into back bumps of chain 75 times. [75 sts cast on]
- Bias stockinette stitch:** Continue working as directed until you have approx. 2 yds/m of yarn left to bind off, or to desired length, ending with WS row. *Note: Join a new skein of yarn in the middle of the row by working 5–6 stitches holding a strand from both the old and new skein together, leaving approx. 8"/20cm tails to weave in later.*
- Finishing:** Bind off and finish as directed in original pattern, blocking to desired dimensions.
