



'CAR COAT': Hip-Length Version
Instructions for creating a hip-length version of your
Churchmouse Classics 'Car Coat' using Brooklyn Tweed Quarry.

Finished Sizes: *Details given for size S; larger sizes in parentheses (). When only one number is given, it applies to all sizes. Refer to schematic on original pattern for all dimensions. Only changes are listed below.*

Hem to underarm length: 12¼"/31cm.

Hem to high shoulder point: 20¾ (21, 21¼, 22)"/53 (53.5, 54, 56)cm.

Yarn: 7 (8, 9, 9) skeins Brooklyn Tweed Quarry (200 yds/182m each).
Or approx. 1385 (1500, 1640, 1800) yds/1266 (1372, 1500, 1646)m of an equivalent chunky-weight yarn. *Note: For this shorter version, we opted to leave pockets off.*
Strong yarn for seaming.

Needles & Five 1-1¼"/25-32mm buttons.

Notions: Five smaller backing buttons.

Please refer to the original pattern for complete instructions.
Only changes are covered in this adaptation. Read original instructions thoroughly.

BACK Cast on and work as directed in original pattern through 'Begin double moss stitch pattern'.

Join hem: Join hem as directed in original pattern. [78 (90, 102, 114) sts]

Work 63 more rows in pattern as established, or the number of rows required to achieve desired length at your blocked row gauge, ending with WS row. *Note: To lengthen or shorten, see Adjusting Body Length on page 3 of original pattern, noting new length of hem to armhole is 12¼"/31cm.*

Proceed to 'Armhole increases' and finish Back as directed in original pattern.

LEFT FRONT Cast on and work as directed through 'Begin double moss stitch pattern and cast on for button band'.

Join hem: Join hem as directed. [49 (55, 61, 67) sts]

Work 63 more rows as established, or number of rows to match back, ending with WS row and proceed to 'Armhole increases' and finish Left Front as directed in original pattern.

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RIGHT FRONT Cast on and work as directed through 'Cast on for button band and begin double moss pattern stitch'.

Join hem: Join hem as directed. [49 (55, 61, 67) sts]

Work 4 rows as established, ending with RS row. Proceed to 'Buttonholes'.

Buttonholes: Work 1 (3, 5, 7) more rows as established, ending with WS row.

Work Buttonhole rows 1–3 as directed in original pattern.

Buttonhole repeat: *Buttonhole rows are worked at the same time through armhole increase section.*

Work 25 rows in pattern; repeat buttonhole rows 1–3. Repeat these 28 rows 2 more times.

Note: 3 (2, 2, 2) buttonholes completed before beginning armhole increases; you will finish working 1 (2, 2, 2) buttonhole(s) before neck shaping. [4 buttonholes total]

AND AT THE SAME TIME

Work 55 (53, 51, 49) rows as established, or number of rows to match back, ending with WS row.

Proceed to 'Armhole increases' and finish Right Front as directed in original pattern.

Work Assembly, Sleeves, Finishing, and Blocking as directed in original pattern, using strong yarn for all seaming.
