



‘COLOR PLAY MOHAIR SCARF & WRAP’: Lang *Alpaca Superlight* version
Instructions for re-yarning your Churchmouse Classics
‘Color Play Mohair Scarf & Wrap’.

- Finished Size:** *Scarf:* Approx. 12 x 64"/30 x 163cm, after blocking.
Wrap: Approx. 20 x 78"/51 x 198cm, after blocking.
Details given for scarf; wrap in parentheses (). When only one number given, it applies to both.
- Yarn:** 4 (8) skeins Lang *Alpaca Superlight* (217 yds/199m each); 1 (2) each of four colors.
Designate Colors A-D. Or approx. 217 (434) yds/199 (398)m each in four colors of an equivalent lace-weight brushed alpaca blend yarn (held double throughout).
- Needles
& Notions:** US 10 (6mm) needles, or size to obtain gauge.
- Gauge:** Approx. 15 sts/21 rows = 4"/10cm in stockinette stitch with yarn held doubled, after blocking.

Only changes are covered in this adaptation.*

Instructions given for scarf; wrap in parentheses (). When only one number given, it applies to both.

- Cast on:** With one strand each of Colors A and B, cast on 45 (75) sts.
- Border:** Work Row 1 as directed in original pattern.
Repeat Row 1 seven more times. [8 rows seed st]
- Body:** Row 1 (RS): (K1, P1) 3 times, PM, knit to last 6 sts, PM, (P1, K1) 3 times. *Note: Hereafter, slip markers as you come to them.*
Row 2 (WS): (K1, P1) 3 times, SM, purl to last 6 sts, SM, (P1, K1) 3 times.
- Color Sequence:** For either scarf or wrap, repeat Body Rows 1 and 2, in following shading sequence:
Section 1: A + B, until piece measures approx. 15 (19)"/38 (48)cm from cast-on edge.
Section 2: B + C, until B runs out. *Note: Blocks will vary in length; you can change color mid-row.*
Section 3: C + D, until C runs out.
Section 4: D + A, until just enough of D and A remain to work 8 rows of seed stitch and bind off (approx. 1.6 (3.2)g or 14 (28) yds/13 (26)m of each yarn).
- Border:** Work Row 1 as directed in original pattern.
Repeat Row 1 seven more times. [8 rows seed st]
Finish and block as directed in original pattern.

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
