



## COMMON TIME COWL

### Lang Cashmere Light and Lana Grossa Brillino Version

*Wide bands created by K4/P4 ribbing makes for a quick and simple knit. And Lana Grossa Brillino adds just the right amount of twinkle to Lang Cashmere Light's loftiness for a cowl that's elegantly cozy!*

- Finished Size:** Approx. 26"/66cm around x 8½"/20.5cm depth, after blocking.
- Yarn:** 2 skeins Lang Cashmere Light (93 yds/85m each) and 1 skein Lana Grossa Brillino (220 yds/201m each), held together throughout.  
Or approx. 186 yds/170m each of an equivalent worsted-weight chainette yarn and lace-weight sparkle yarn held together throughout.
- Needles** US 10½ (6.5mm) 24"/60cm circular needle, or size to obtain gauge.  
**& Notions:** Stitch marker.  
Blunt darning needle to finish.
- Gauge:** Approx. 17 sts = 4"/10cm in K4/P4 ribbing, after blocking.
- Glossary:** **K** = knit; **P** = purl; **St(s)** = stitch(es).
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- The construction of chainette yarns adds a lot of stretch and bounce, so gauge can be difficult to achieve. While you're knitting, try pulling out a few yards from the ball at a time, so you're not working with a lot of tension on the yarn. Don't worry too much if your gauge is off slightly—this cowl is quite forgiving!*
- Cast on:** Holding one strand of each yarn, using cable cast-on method, cast on 112 sts. Place marker and join in the round, being careful not to twist.
- 4x4 Ribbing:** Round 1: \*K4, P4\*; repeat between \* \* to end.  
Repeat Round 1 until piece measures approx. 8.5"/20.5cm, or desired length, from cast-on edge. Make sure you have approx. 5 yds/m for your bind-off.
- Bind off:** Bind off in pattern, keeping tension even to match cast-on edge. *Note: Adjust your needle size up or down if you're having trouble matching tension.* Cut yarn; fasten off.
- Finishing:** Weave in ends as invisibly as possible.  
Soak piece for 20 minutes in tepid water with no-rinse wool soap. Gently squeeze out as much water as possible. Roll in towel and squeeze out more moisture. Lay flat on moisture-safe blocking surface and pin to desired dimensions. Let dry completely.  
Gently steam press with press cloth, pressing out any folds. Allow to dry thoroughly.

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
