



‘CROCHETED BASKETS’: Double Stranded Version
Instructions for resizing your Churchmouse At Home ‘Crocheted Baskets’
holding two strands of Hemp For Knitting *AllHemp6*.

*With your yarn held doubled, it’s still super quick to whip up an extra extra large, extra extra sturdy crocheted basket!
Place a potted plant inside for a little extra charm. Or use it to carry around your next project!*

Finished Size: *Extra Extra Large:* Approx. 10"/25.5cm across x 9"/23cm tall.

Yarn: 4 skeins Hemp For Knitting *AllHemp6* (165 yds/150m each), held double throughout.
Or approx. 660 yds/600m of an equivalent DK-weight cotton or hemp yarn, held double.

**Needles
& Notions:** US I/9 (5.5mm) crochet hook, or size to obtain gauge.

Gauge: Approx. 13 sc in the round = 4"/10cm.

*Please refer to the original pattern for complete instructions.
Only changes are covered in this adaptation.*

Base: Holding two strands of yarn together throughout, cast on as directed in original pattern.
Work through Round 18 of base. [108 sts]
Work Turning Round as directed in original pattern.

Body: Repeat straight round as directed in original pattern until piece measures approx. 9"/23cm tall or desired height, or until you have just enough yarn left to tie off.

Finishing: Finish as directed in original pattern and weave in all ends as invisibly as possible on WS.
Note: Do not steam or wet-block if you prefer a stiffer fabric.
