



‘DIAGONAL LACE SCARF & WRAP’: Rauma *Alpakka Lin* Version
Instructions for knitting your Churchmouse Classics
‘Diagonal Lace Scarf & Wrap’ pattern in Rauma *Alpakka Lin*.

The slightly wider dimension of this piece together with the soft featheriness of the linen and alpaca blend yarn make it a perfect cool-weather scarf or warm-weather wrap!

- Finished Size:** Approx. 16 x 78"/40 x 198cm
- Yarn:** 3 skeins Rauma *Alpakka Lin* (191 yds/175m each). Or approx. 573 yds/525m of an equivalent worsted-weight yarn.
- Needles** US 8 (5mm) needles, or size to obtain gauge.
& Notions: 2 stitch markers.
Darning needle to finish.
Blocking wires and T-pins.
- Gauge:** Approx. 14 sts = 4"/10cm, after blocking and resting.

*Please refer to the original pattern for complete instructions.
Only changes are covered in this adaptation.*

- Cast on:** With gauge needle, using cable cast-on method, cast on 58 sts. Work first garter stitch edge.
- Diagonal Lace Stitch:** Work until piece is approx. 77–78"/196–198cm long, or to about ½"/1cm less than desired length, making sure you have enough yarn to knit 3 more rows and bind off.
End with a RS row.

Work final garter stitch edge. Finish as instructed in original pattern.
- Blocking:** Since this yarn is a blend of animal fibers and linen, wet block according to pattern instructions for blocking animal fibers.
