



## 'DIAGONAL LACE SCARF': Hemp For Knitting allhemp6 Version

### Instructions for re-yarning your Churchmouse Classics

#### 'Diagonal Lace Scarf & Wrap' pattern in *allhemp6*.

*Our easy-to-knit 'Diagonal Lace Scarf' is so lovely for warmer weather. We couldn't resist re-yarning it in summer-friendly hemp. Mercerized allhemp6 won't fade or pill, and only gets softer and more lustrous with each washing and drying. How perfect is that around your neck?*

**Finished Size:** Approx. 8 x 66"/20 x 168cm.

**Yarn:** 2 skeins Hemp for Knitting *allhemp6* (165 yds/150m each).  
Or approx. 330 yds/300m of an equivalent DK-weight plant fiber yarn.

**Needles & Notions:** US 8 (5mm) needles, or size to obtain gauge.

**Gauge:** Approx. 17 sts = 4"/10cm in pattern stitch, after blocking.

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*Please refer to the original pattern for complete instructions.  
Only changes are covered in this adaptation.*

**Cast on:** Using long-tail cast-on method, cast on 34 sts.  
Work first garter-stitch edge as directed in original pattern.

**Diagonal lace stitch:** Work forty-seven repeats of 8-row diagonal lace pattern, or repeat Rows 1–8 until piece measures approx. 66"/168cm or desired length, making sure to leave approx. 10 yds/m for final 3 rows and bind-off.  
Work final garter-stitch edge and bind-off as directed in original pattern.

**Blocking:** Machine wash on warm; lay flat to dry. Pin scarf to finished size. When nearly dry, place in warm dryer to soften and 'polish' the yarn.
