

## JOLLY WEE ELF: Jamieson's Version

Instructions for re-yarning your Churchmouse At Home 'Jolly Wee Elf' pattern using Jamieson's fingering-weight *Shetland Spindrift*.

Yarn: For Tiny Wee Elf: 3 skeins Jamieson's Shetland Spindrift (115 yds/105m each):

1 skein each of main color (MC), hat color (HC) and scarf color (SC).

3 skeins of Appleton Wool Ltd. crewel yarn (27 yds/25m each) in various face colors (FC).

Makes approx. 12 Tiny Wee Elves. Use different combinations of colors for body, hats and

scarves so colors are used up evenly.

Please refer to original pattern for complete instructions.
Only changes are covered in this adaptation.

Base & shoulder

shaping:

Using MC yarn, follow instructions as directed in original pattern through Round 4 of

shoulder shaping.

Rounds 5–6: Knit. Break yarn leaving 8"/20cm tail to bury later. Fasten off.

**Face shaping:** Using 2 strands of crewel yarn in FC held together, follow instructions for face shaping.

Begin hat: Using HC yarn, complete hat, working as directed in original pattern.

Finishing: Neck definition: Thread 2 FC tails through darning needle and work running stitch in and

out around base of face; pull to define neck a little. Fasten off; bury ends. Thread remaining 2 FC tails through darning needle and repeat, working in opposite direction. Fasten off;

bury ends.
