



## LAST-MINUTE COWL: QUARRY VERSION

*Using fat US 17 (12mm) needles and doubling up on chunky-weight Quarry, this cowl can be knit up in a jiff! Choose between textured seed stitch or classic K2/P2 ribbing.*

- Finished Size:** *Seed-stitch version:* Approx. 24"/61cm around x 9"/23cm deep.  
*K2/P2 ribbed version:* Approx. 28"/71cm around x 12"/31cm deep.
- Yarn:** *Seed-stitch version:* 1 skein Brooklyn Tweed Quarry (200 yds/183m each) held doubled throughout; or approx. 200 yds/183m chunky-weight yarn held doubled.  
*K2/P2 ribbed version:* 1 skein each of 2 colors Brooklyn Tweed Quarry (200 yds/183m each) held together throughout; or approx. 175 yds/160m each of 2 colors chunky-weight yarn held together.
- Needles & Notions:** *Both versions:* US 17 (12–12.75mm) 24"/60cm circular needle, or size to obtain gauge.  
Large marker. Darning needle to finish.
- Gauge:** *Both versions:* Approx 8 sts = 4"/10cm, after blocking. *Note: Just get close.*
- Glossary:** K = knit; P = purl; St(s) = stitch(es).
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- Seed-stitch version:** Holding yarn doubled and using cable cast-on method, cast on 49 sts. Do not join in the round yet.  
Set-up round: \*P1, K1\*; repeat between \* \* to last st, P1. Join in the round, being careful not to twist. Place marker to denote beginning of round.  
Round 1: \*K1, P1\*; repeat between \* \* to last st, K1.  
Round 2: \*P1, K1\*; repeat between \* \* to last st, P1.  
Repeat Rounds 1 and 2 until cowl measures 9"/23cm, or desired depth, from cast-on and you have just enough yarn left to bind off. Proceed to 'finishing' below.
- K2/P2 ribbed version:** Holding one strand of each color together and using cable cast-on method, cast on 60 sts. Do not join in the round yet.  
Set-up round: \*K2, P2\*; repeat between \* \* to end. Join in the round, being careful not to twist. Place marker to denote beginning of round.  
Round 1: \*K2, P2\*; repeat between \* \* to end of round.  
Repeat Round 1 until cowl measures 12"/31cm, or desired depth, from cast-on and you have just enough yarn left to bind off. Proceed to 'finishing' below.
- Finishing:** Bind off loosely in pattern for seed-stitch version, more firmly for K2/P2 ribbed version. Weave in ends on wrong side. Damp-, wet- or steam-block, as needed. Or as time allows!

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
