



**PRETTY PERFECT SQUARE: Ito Sensai Striped Version**  
**Instructions for re-yarning your Churchmouse Classics**  
**‘Pretty Perfect Square’ pattern in Ito Sensai**

- Finished Size:** 22"/56cm square, after blocking.
- Yarn:** 4 skeins ITO Sensai (262 yds/240m each): one skein each Colors A, B, C, and D.  
We used: A = 693 Chili Pepper; B = 348 Iron Blue; C = 330 White; D = 320 Snow Gray.
- Needles:** As original pattern.
- Gauge:** 26 sts/44 rows = 4"/10cm in stockinette stitch, after blocking. *Note: See original pattern, page 2, for instructions on swatching and determining your actual personal row gauge for final row count.*

Only changes are covered in this adaptation.*

- 4-color uneven stripes:** Based on our swatched gauge, we cast on 144 sts and worked a total of **241 rows** to create a 22"/56cm blocked square.

Begin and end each section with a RS row, sliding stitches to opposite end of needle when necessary (tails will alternate from one side edge to the other).

*Note: Remember, do not slip first 2 sts on first row of new color.*

A - Begin with RS row, work 37 rows

B - 31 rows

C - 23 rows

D - 35 rows

B - 15 rows

C - 25 rows

A - 15 rows

D - 35 rows

B - 25 rows, ending with RS row; do not cut yarn. Turn work to bind off on WS.

*Note: If your blocked row gauge requires a different number of rows than ours to be square, just add or delete rows in this final section, ending with a RS row.*

- Finishing:** Bind off and block as per finishing instructions given in original pattern.
