

'SHOULDER COZY': Brushed Fleece and Brillino Version

Instructions for re-yarning your Churchmouse Classics 'Shoulder Cozy' pattern holding Rowan Brushed Fleece and Lana Grossa Brillino together and adding a cowl neck in four sizes.

Finished Sizes: 1 (2, 3, 4)

To fit: 4–7 year old (8–12 year old, Adult S/M, Adult L/XL).

Details given for Size 1; larger sizes in parentheses ().

Without cowl: Approx. 9 (11, 16, 18)"/23 (28, 41, 46)cm long when laid flat, after blocking. *With cowl:* Approx. 13½ (16½, 24, 26)"/34 (42, 61, 66)cm long when laid flat, after blocking.

Yarns: Without cowl: 1 (2, 3, 3) skein(s) Rowan Brushed Fleece (115 yds/105m each) and 1 (1, 2, 2)

skein(s) Lana Grossa *Brillino* (220 yds/201m each) <u>held together</u> throughout. Or approx. 115 (155, 284, 340) yds/105 (142, 260, 310)m <u>each</u> of an equivalent bulky-weight yarn <u>and</u> lace-

weight yarn.

With cowl: 2 (2, 4, 4) skeins Rowan Brushed Fleece (115 yds/105m each) and 1 (1, 2, 2) skein(s) Lana Grossa Brillino (220 yds/201m each) held together throughout. Or approx. 142 (205, 390, 426) yds/130 (187, 357, 390)m each of an equivalent bulky-weight yarn and lace-

weight yarn.

Needles US 15 (10mm) 24"/60cm circular needle, or size to obtain gauge.

& Notions: Sizes 1 and 2 only: Set of 5 double-point needles same size as gauge needle.

Gauge: Approx. 9 sts = 4"/10cm in garter stitch (yarns <u>held together</u> throughout), after blocking.

Please refer to original pattern for complete instructions.
Only changes are covered in this adaptation.

Instructions given for Size 1; larger sizes in parentheses ().

Cast on: Holding a strand of <u>each</u> yarn together, cast on 68 (76, 100, 100) sts as directed in original

pattern.

Row 1: Work as directed in original pattern.

Garter stitch: Work as directed in original pattern until work measures approx. 4½ (5½, 8, 9)"/11.5 (14,

20, 23)cm from cast-on edge, ending with a purl round.

Shaping rounds: <u>1st Dec round</u>: Work as directed in original pattern. [51 (57, 75, 75) sts]

Continue in garter stitch until piece measures approx. 7 ($8\frac{1}{2}$, 12, 14)"/18 (21.5, 30, 36)cm.

2nd Dec round: Work as directed in original pattern, changing to double-points if needed.

[34 (38, 50, 50) sts]

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Continue in garter stitch until piece measures approx. 9 (11, 16, 18)"/23 (28, 41, 46)cm.

If adding cowl neck, proceed to 'Cowl neck' below; if not adding cowl, bind off and finish as

directed in original pattern and proceed to 'blocking' on next page.

Cowl neck (optional):

Continue working straight in garter stitch until piece measures 13½ (16½, 24, 26)"/34 (42, 61, 66)cm from cast-on edge, or desired length, and you have enough yarn to complete a purl round and bind off.

Bind off and finish as directed in original pattern. Proceed to 'blocking' below.

Blocking:

Soak piece for 20 minutes in tepid water with a little no-rinse wool soap. Gently squeeze out as much water as possible. Roll in a towel and gently squeeze out more moisture.

Lay piece on moisture-safe surface and pin to finished length, slightly stretching hemline and neckline. If you have soft, bendable blocking wires, slip one into each side fold and pin into gentle curves. Allow to dry thoroughly.

Remove wires and gently steam press with press cloth to remove any fold lines; let dry.
